CORRESPONDENCE COURSES Students enrolling in Correspondence Courses will be charged at the same rates listed above. However, tuition for these courses is calculated separately and added to any Main or Branch Campus tuition.

Footnotes:

- (1) Non-resident students are charged resident rates for Summer only, except for students in the Nursing program (see Fall Tuition & Fee rates).
- (2) Undergrad & Non-degree undergrad rates for students with no baccalaureate degree, except Nursing students (see Fall Tuition & Fee rates).
- (3) Grad & Non-degree grad rates for students with baccalaureate degree or higher, except Nursing students (see Fall Tuition & Fee rates).
- (4) All full-time Physical Therapy D students are charged additional flat tuition fee of \$1,795.00
- (5) Add \$45 per credit hour for graduate level Architecture, Planning and Landscape Architecture courses.
- (6) Add \$75 per credit hour for graduate level Anderson School of Management (ASM) courses.
- (7) Add \$25 per credit hour for graduate level Public Administration courses.

Courses beginning on dates other than those listed above, as listed in the *Schedule of Classes* available on LoboWeb, are fully refundable if dropped before 20% of the course has been completed, except for Correspondence courses (see paragraph below). Do not include partial days when calculating 20% of completion. For example, 20% of an eight-day course equals 1.6 days. Refund is calculated only if dropped on or before the first day. Courses five days or less in duration must be dropped on or before the first day of the course to receive a full refund.

Correspondence Courses are fully refundable if dropped before 9% of the course has been completed. Do not include partial days when calculating 9% of completion.

Tuition and fees for courses dropped after the above deadlines will not be refunded.

Students may not drop a course by simply not attending. They are responsible for officially dropping or withdrawing from the University by the published deadlines (see above information) to insure proper credit of tuition and fees. A student's readmission, registration, library or parking privileges, release of official records, and other requests may be restricted or denied unless satisfactory financial arrangements have been made for all past due charges.
