**100% Refund Deadlines:** Full-Term Courses (16 weeks)...February 8, 2008  
 12-Week Courses...February 1, 2008; First 8-Week Courses...February 1, 2008; Second 8-Week Courses...April 4, 2008

**100% Refund Deadlines for Nursing Students:** Full-Term Courses (01/17-04/28)...January 28, 2008  
 First Half-Term Courses (01/17-03/05)...January 21, 2008; Second Half-Term Courses (03/10-04/28)...March 14, 2008

Courses beginning on dates other than those listed above are fully refundable if dropped before 20% of the course has been completed, except Correspondence Courses, as posted in the Schedule of Classes.  
 Do not include partial days when calculating 20% of completion. For example, 20% of an 8 day course equals 1.6 days. Refund is calculated only if dropped on or before the first day.  
 Courses 5 days or less in duration must be dropped on or before the first day of the course to receive a full refund. Tuition and fees for courses dropped after the above deadlines will not be refunded.  
 Correspondence Courses, if dropped before 9% of the course has been completed, are fully refundable.

Students may not drop a course by simply not attending. They are responsible for officially dropping or withdrawing from the University by the published deadlines (see above information) to insure proper credit of tuition and fees. A student's readmission, registration, library or parking privileges, release of official records, and other requests may be restricted or denied unless satisfactory financial arrangements have been made for all past due charges.

**SENIOR CITIZENS**

You qualify for a reduced tuition rate of \$5.00/credit hour if you are:  
 \* Age 65 or older as of 21st day from the start of the semester.  
 \* A New Mexico resident as defined by the NM Department of Higher Ed.  
 \* Registering for no more than six (6) credit hours.  
 \* Registering on or after January 22, 2008 for the Spring semester.

Resident tuition and fee charges, 1 -18 hours	\$562.00
Non-resident tuition and fee charges, 1 - 6 hours	\$562.00
Non-resident tuition and fee charges, 7 hours and above	\$562.00 plus \$640.05/hr over 7

- (1) Non-resident students enrolled for 6 hours or less pay the resident rate. If enrolled for 7 hours or more, non-resident students pay the indicated non-resident tuition for ALL credit hours taken.
- (2) Grad, Grad-ASM, Law, Pharm D, Dissertation, and Med students pay a \$25 GPSA fee per semester (\$50/yr).
- (3) NU/Non-degree undergrad rates for students with no baccalaureate degree.
- (4) NG/Non-degree grad rates for students with baccalaureate degree or higher.
- (5) All full-time Pharm D students admitted Fall 2006 or after are charged additional flat tuition fee of \$1,932.50.
- (6) Add \$30 per credit hour for graduate level Architecture, Planning and Landscape Architecture courses.
- (7) Add \$50 per credit hour for graduate level Anderson School of Management (ASM) courses.
