## **Reduced Tuition for Senior Citizens**

A student qualifies for a reduced tuition rate of \$5.00 per credit hour if they are:

- A New Mexico resident as defined by the NM Department of Higher Ed
- Age 65 or older as of the 21<sup>st</sup> day from the starts of the semester
- Registering for no more than 10 credit hours
- Registering on or after June 6, 2022

## **Tuition Refund Deadlines**
