#### **REDUCED TUITION FOR SENIOR CITIZENS**

A student qualifies for a reduced tuition rate of \$5.00 per credit hour if they are:

- A New Mexico resident as defined by the NM Department of Higher Ed
- Age 65 or older as of the 21<sup>st</sup> day from the starts of the semester
- Registering for no more than 10 credit hours
- Registering on or after August 21, 2023

#### **REFUND DEADLINES**

Courses must be dropped by 5:00 PM on the listed day to receive the refund:

**Open Learning Courses**, or courses that are outside the traditional schedule, are fully refundable if dropped before 20% of the course has been completed. Do not include partial days when calculating 20% of completion. For example, 20% of an 8-day course equals 1.6 days; therefore, the refund is calculated only if the course is dropped on or before the first day. Courses with a duration of 5 days or less must be dropped on or before the first day of the course to receive a full refund.

<u>A course is not dropped by not attending</u>. It is the student's responsibility to officially drop or withdraw from UNM by the published deadline (see above) to ensure proper credit for tuition and fees is received.
